DECLARATION-CUM-UNDERTAKING

It is hereby solemnly declares and undertakes that the Academic Council and the Board of Management, through their respective resolutions dated 04 November 2024 and 05 November 2024, have duly approved the offering of academic programmes in the Online Learning (OL) Mode in accordance with the provisions of the Mewar University, Chittorgarh Act, 2009.

The approval has been granted in compliance with the powers and functions conferred under Sections 2(c), 2(d), 2(x), 5(c), 5(e), 5(j), 5(w), 5(y), and 5(z) of the Act, read with the relevant provisions of the Statutes of Mewar University, Chittorgarh, including Statute 1(e), 1(h), 1(k), 1(x), Statute (j), and Statute (k), as applicable.

The HEI further affirms that all statutory approvals, academic requirements, and regulatory provisions prescribed under the University Act and Statutes have been duly complied with for the purpose of offering programmes through the OL mode

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- xxi. The Directorate will develop Norms for implementation of various Open & Distance Education including quality issues and will take all such steps as it may deem fit and proper in respect of maintenance of the standards thereof;
- xxii. The Directorate will control and coordinate implementation of Open & Distance Education programs of the university;
- xxiii. The Directorate will prescribe standard requirements in respect of staff, buildings, furniture and equipment, stationary and other thing required for Open & Distance Education Centers.
- xxiv. The Directorate will exercise such other powers and perform such other functions as may be conferred or imposed on it by Board of Management.
The Directorate will do all such acts and things as may be necessary to carry out the purpose of Act, Regulations and statutes.

K. DIRECTORATE OF ONLINE EDUCATION & E-LEARNING AND BLENDED LEARNING

13. The Directorate of Online Education & E-learning and Blended Learning shall be constituted by the Chairperson.
Provided that the Directorate of Online Education & E-learning and Blended Learning shall be reconstituted once every three year.
Provided further that, the Chairperson may, under extenuating circumstances, if he deems fit, reconstitute the Directorate of Online Education & E-learning and Blended Learning before the expiry of its term.
- (1) The Directorate of Online Education & E-learning and Blended Learning shall consist of the following members, namely
 - (i) Director - Chairman
 - (ii) Registrar of the University
 - (iii) Two experts of Online Education & E-learning and Blended Learning, not below the rank of Professor, nominated by the Chairperson
 - (iv) Deputy Registrar shall be of the member Secretary
 - (2) The meeting of the Directorate of Online Education & E-learning and Blended Learning shall be convened by the Member Secretary of the Directorate on such date, time and place as may be decided by the Director of the Directorate of Online Education & E-learning and Blended Learning. The Directorate of Online Education & E-learning and Blended Learning shall ordinarily meet at least once a year. Three members of the Directorate of Online Education & E-learning and Blended Learning shall form the quorum for the meeting.
 - (3) The recommendations of all the Directorate of Online Education & E-learning and Blended Learning shall be placed for approval before the Board of Management of the University.



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- (4) The Director of the Directorate of Online Education & E-learning and Blended Learning shall be appointed by Chairperson of the University for the period of three years, who will be member of the Academic Council.
- (5) The Deputy Registrar of the University shall be ex-officio Member Secretary of the Directorate of Online Education & E-learning and Blended Learning.
- (6) The Chairperson may remove the Director by order in writing on grounds of omission or refusal to carry out the provisions of the Act, Statutes, regulations or in case the Director abuses powers vested in him or misbehaves or mismanage or his conduct involves moral turpitude or if it otherwise appears to the Chairperson that the continuance of the Director in the office is detrimental to the interest of the Directorate of Online Education & E-learning and Blended Learning or the University.
- (7) The Chairperson may suspend the Director of Directorate of Online Education & E-learning and Blended Learning during enquiry depending upon the seriousness of the charges as it deems fit.
- (8) Subject to the provisions of the Act, the statutes and the ordinances, the Directorate of Online Education & E-learning and Blended Learning, in addition to all other powers vested under the Act, shall have following powers and functions:
 - i. To organize and offer Online Education & E-learning and Blended learning in the University;
 - ii. To appoint members of teaching and administrative staff on the recommendations of the Selection Committee constituted for the purpose and all such appointees shall be the employees of the University and shall be governed by the Act, these Statute, Ordinances, Rules and Regulations;
 - iii. To develop the curriculum for all the subjects of Online Education & E-learning and Blended Learning programs of the University;
 - iv. To develop learning and training support material for the guidance of the teachers and students, to prescribe or publish text books for Online Education & E-learning and Blended Learning educational programs of the University.
 - v. To define appropriate approaches of Online Education & E-learning and Blended Learning activities to provide stress free, student centers and holistic education to all students without compromising on quality.
 - vi. To analyses and monitor the quality of Online Education & E-learning and Blended Learning programs by collecting the feedback from different stakeholders.
 - vii. To prescribe the general conditions governing admission of regular and external students to the final examinations and to specify the conditions regarding attendance and character, on the fulfillment of which a student's shall have right to be admitted to and to appear at any university examinations.
 - viii. To demand and receive such fee as may be prescribed, from students registered with University.


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- ix. To develop norms for implementation of various Online Education & E-learning and Blended Learning Education activities including quality issues;
- x. to control and coordinate the implementation of Online Education & E-learning and Blended Learning Education programs of the university;
- xi. To recommend the rule for purpose of carrying into effect the provisions of this Statute.
- xii. To make guidelines relating to Online Education & E-learning and Blended Learning Education Programs.
- xiii. To organize various capacity building and empowerment programs to update the professional competency of teachers.
- xiv. To recommend paper setters, translators, examiners, moderators, supervisors and other necessary personnel for conducting the Online Education & E-learning and Blended Learning Education examination, for evaluation of students' performance and for compiling and release result in accordance with such instructions as the Academic Council may from time to time issue.
- xv. To open Centre in and outside the country for the Online Education & E-learning and Blended Learning Education and examination conducted by it;
- xvi. The Directorate of Online Education & E-learning and Blended Learning Education shall organize and promote Online Education & E-learning and Blended Learning Education in the University. The decisions of the Directorate of Online Education & E-learning and Blended Learning will be consistent with the overall academic program of action decided by the Academic Council. In case, the decisions of the Directorate of Online Education & E-learning and Blended Learning Education are not consistent with such overall academic program of action, the Academic Council shall be competent to review and modify such decisions.
- xvii. The Directorate of Online Education & E-learning and Blended Learning Education shall have all powers necessary to promote Online Education & E-learning and Blended Learning Education in India and Abroad.
- xviii. The Directorate of Online Education & E-learning and Blended Learning Education shall consult the Board of Management on any such matters, which may have direct impact on administration, and management of the University before deciding upon it. Further, the Registrar shall facilitate the process of consultation with the Board of Management for the purpose of this clause.
- xix. The Directorate shall have powers to frame Rules and Guidelines for the purpose of Directorate of Online Education & E-learning and Blended Learning Education.
- xx. The Directorate will make guidelines relating to Online Education & E-learning and Blended Learning Education and procedure to be followed by the students.

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- xxi. The Directorate will develop Norms for implementation of various Online Education & E-learning and Blended Learning Education including quality issues and will take all such steps as it may deem fit and proper in respect of maintenance of the standards thereof;
- xxii. The Directorate will control and coordinate implementation of Online Education & E-learning and Blended Learning Educational programs of the university;
- xxiii. The Directorate will prescribe standard requirements in respect of staff, buildings, furniture, equipment, stationary and other thing required for Online Education & E-learning and Blended Learning Education Centers.
- xxiv. The Directorate will exercise such other powers and perform such other functions as may be conferred or imposed on it by Board of Management. The Directorate will do all such acts and things as may be necessary to carry out the purpose of Act, Regulations and statutes.

L. Directorate of Vocational Education and Skill Development.

14. The Skill and Vocational Education Development Council shall consist of following:-
- a) President – Chairman,
 - b) Three nominees of Chairperson - Member,
 - c) One Dean of Faculty nominated by President – Member,
 - d) Registrar – Member Secretary
- (1) The Skill and Vocational Education Development Council shall be constituted by the Chairperson in accordance with the provisions of the Act. Provided that the Skill and Vocational Education Development Council shall be reconstituted once every three year. Provided further that, the Chairperson may, under extenuating circumstances, if he deems fit, reconstitute the Community College Development Council before the expiry of its term.
- (2) The Skill and Vocational Education Development Council shall ordinarily meet at least twice a year and on such occasions as may be directed by the Chairperson.
- (3) The Skill and Vocational Education Development Council shall have following powers and functions:
- (i) To provide for collaboration with Industry and Skill & Vocational Training provider.
 - (ii) To recognize and approve Industry and Skill & Vocational Training provider for conducting any Skill Development and/or Vocation program/course.
 - (iii) The decisions of the Skill and Vocational Education Development Council shall be placed before the Board of Management for ratification. If upon review the Board of Management finds that decisions of the Skill and Vocational Education Development Council may adverse impact on administration and management of the University, the Board of Management

**THE MEWAR UNIVERSITY, CHITTORGARH ACT, 2009
(Act No. 4 of 2009)**

**(Received the assent of the Governor on the 3rd day of
February, 2009)**

Act

to provide for establishment and incorporation of the Mewar University, Chittorgarh in the State of Rajasthan and matters connected there with and incidental thereto.

Whereas, with a view to keep pace with the rapid development in all spheres of knowledge in the world and the country, it is essential to create world level modern research and study facilities in the State to provide state of the art educational facilities to the youth at their door steps so that they can make out of them human resources compatible to liberalized economic and social order of the world;

And whereas, rapid advancement in knowledge and changing requirements of human resources makes it essential

And whereas, if the aforesaid infrastructure is utilized in
incorporation as a University and the said Mewar Education
Society, Chittorgarh is allowed to run the University, it
would contribute in the academic development of the people of
the State;

Now, therefore, be it enacted by the Rajasthan State Legislature
in the Fifty-ninth Year of the Republic of India, as follows :-

1. Short title, extent and commencement :-

- (1) This Act may be called the Mewar University,
Chittorgarh, Act, 2009.
- (2) It extends to the whole of the State of Rajasthan.
- (3) It shall be deemed to have come into force on and
from 21st September, 2008.

**2. Definitions :- In this Act, unless the context otherwise
requires :-**


- (a) "AICTE" means All India Council of Technical
Education established under All India Council of
Technical Education Act, 1987 (Central Act No. 52 of
1987);
- (b) "CSIR" means the Council of Scientific and Industrial
Research, New Delhi - a fundi Mewar University,
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Central Government;
- (c) "DEC" means the Distance Education Council
established under section 28 of Indira Gandhi
National Open University Act, 1985 (Central Act No.
50 of 1985);
- (d) "Distance Education" means education imparted
by combination of any two or more means of

communication, viz broadcasting, telecasting, correspondence courses, seminars, contact programmes and any other such methodology;

- (e) "DST" means the Department of Science and Technology of the Central Government;
- (f) "employee" means a person appointed by the University to work in the University and includes teachers, officers and other employees of the University;
- (g) "fee" means collection made by the University from the students by whatever name it may be called, which is not refundable;
- (h) "Government" means the State Government of Rajasthan;
- (i) "higher education" means study of a curriculum or course for the pursuit of knowledge beyond 10+2 level;
- (j) "hostel" means a place of residence for the students of the University, or its colleges, institutions or centers, maintained or recognized to be as such by the University;
- (k) "ICAR" means the Indian Council of Agriculture Research, a society registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 (Central Act No. 21 of 1860);
- (l) "MCI" means Medical Council of India constituted under section 3 of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 (Central Act No. 102 of 1956);
- (m) "NAAC" means the National Assessment and Accreditation Council, Bangalore, an autonomous Institution of the UGC;

arrangements with other institutions or bodies as the University may deem necessary;

- (n) to determine standards for admission into the University, which may include examination, evaluation or any other method of testing;
- (o) to demand and receive payment of fees and other charges;
- (p) to supervise the residences of the students of the University and to make arrangements for the promotion of their health and general welfare;
- (q) to make special arrangements in respect of female students as the University may consider desirable;
- (r) to regulate and enforce discipline among the employees and students of the University and take such disciplinary measures in this regard as may be deemed necessary by the University;
- (s) to make arrangements for promoting the health and general welfare of the employees of the University;
- (t) to receive donations and acquire, hold, manage and dispose of any moveable or immovable property;
- (u) to borrow money with the approval of the Sponsoring Body for the purposes of the University;
- (v) to mortgage or hypothecate the property of the University with the approval of the Sponsoring Body;
- (w) to establish and operate examination centers;


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
